# Art

Throughout the year, students will study the elements of art and apply them in a variety of forms to student generated works of art. Students will create a portfolio of work and the year will culminate with an art show where students display their best work.

# Geography (1 semester)

Students will examine the physical, cultural, economic, environmental, and political characteristics of the world's regions from a geographic perspective.

### Government (1 semester)

Students will study the development and application of the American democratic principles and the United States Constitution. Students will investigate the rights, responsibilities, and duties of American citizenship at the national, state, and local level including political and civic participation.

# Logic and Reasoning

In this class, students will explore deductive and inductive reasoning, logical fallacies, making inferences, and how to build clear arguments using methods such as puzzles, simulations, current events, and classroom discussion.

#### PE

Students will learn health and wellness core concepts and develop motor skills, knowledge, and behaviors for physical fitness through participation in structured exercises, games, and team sports.
